



The impact of the digital revolution on the labour market: an interview with IAB Director Joachim Möller

Is the digital revolution a job-destroyer or a job-creator? How will it change traditional occupational images? In an interview to the IAB-Forum magazine, IAB Director <u>Joachim Möller</u> discusses these questions and argues for a "flexibility compromise" between the social partners as a strategy to organize the consequences of technological change on the labour market in a productive and socially acceptable manner.
